
It has been a great pleasure serving the King of kings and Lord of lords!

ABOUT THE BALKANS

THE BALKAN PENINSULA IS COMPOSED OF THESE COUNTRIES:

Croatia, Serbia, Montenegro, Kosovo, Slovenia, Albania, North Macedonia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Hungary, Greece and a little piece of Turkey.



OUR VISION

Reach the lost in the Balkans with the Gospel by evangelizing, discipling, starting churches, and training men to do the same.

Our plan is to begin our ministry in Albania, but with the goal of reaching the entire Balkan region with the Gospel.

The harvest is white, but the laborers are few.

OUR PLANS

1- LANGUAGE LEARNING

The first thing we want to do is to learn the language (Albanian), and learn the Culture. This is essential for effective ministry to happen.

2- BOLD EVANGELISM

Although Albania is a mostly Muslim country, they are wide open to the gospel. They do not have restrictions and we aim to take advantage of that.

3- INTENSE DISCIPIESHIP

As people come to accept Christ as their Savior, our goal is to disciple and train men to be leaders.

4- CHURCH PLANTING

When these men are discipled and trained, they will be sent out as pastors to churches and start churches throughout the entire region. They will be trained to evangelize the lost, disciple the believers, train up men as leaders, and to start churches themselves.

TRAINING

Church planting – We have the privilege to Spend a year and a half on staff working in a new church plant in the state of São Paulo - Brazil.

- Children's ministry: Planned and directed VBS, and started a Children's weekly Bible club.
- Evangelism: Went door to door knocking, passing out tracks and invitations, as well as engaging in conversations to share the Gospel.
- Discipleship: Had the opportunity to teach several Bible studies, and disciple individuals to be true followers of Christ.
- Youth ministry: Working with the youth was especially exciting to see because of their desire and excitement to learn and act out the Word of God. We created fun activities and specific Bible lessons that would lead them to Christ and help them in their walk with Christ.
- Preaching: Was given many opportunities to preach in several different Churches and help fill-in for pastors.
- Camp Ministry: Organized and directed several different events for Camp. Pastoring – Spent one year as a senior pastor of Igreja Batista Vida & Paz in the state of Rio de Janeiro Brazil.
- During this time I had the great privilege of preaching the Word of God during services and teaching the Bible for Sunday school.
- Organized outreach and evangelism in the neighborhood where the church
- · Visited and encouraged members and visitors that came to the church, which was always a great to see God Work.
- We also started a soccer outreach at the church that allowed me to work with young men, preach the Gospel and invite them to church.













OUR DOCTRINAL STATEMENT

THE BIBLE

We believe that the Bible is the Word of God and that it is divinely inspired. We believe in plenary, verbal inspiration-that the Bible is the only complete and final revelation of the will of God to man and that it is the supreme, infallible authority in all matters of faith and conduct. We use the King James Bible for all teaching and preaching in English. (IITimothy 3:16; II Peter 1:20,21; Mark 13:31; John 8:31,32; John 20:31; Acts

20:32)

GOD

We believe in the Trinity, the unity of the Godhead. There are three persons: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. They are equally perfect in every divine quality and execute distinct but harmonious offices in the great work of redemption. (A) We believe in God the Father. (B) We believe in Jesus Christ. (C) We believe in the Holy Spirit. (Genesis 1:1,26; John 1:1,3; Matthew 28:19; John 4:24; Romans 1:19,20; Ephesians 4:5,6)

THE FATHER

We believe in God the Father, an infinite, personal spirit, perfect in holiness, wisdom, power, and love. We believe that He infallibly foreknows all that shall come to pass, that He concerns Himself mercifully in the affairs of men, that He hears and answers prayer, and that He saves from sin and death all who come to Him through Jesus Christ. (Luke 10:21,22; Matthew 23:9; John 3:16; 6:27; Romans 1:7; I Timothy 1:1,2; 2:5,6; I Peter 1:3; Revelation 1:6)


JESUS CHRIST

We believe in Jesus Christ, God's only begotten Son, conceived by the Holy Spirit. We believe Jesus Christ is God. We believe in His virgin birth, sinless life, miracles, and teachings. We believe in His substitutionary atoning death, bodily resurrection, ascension into heaven, perpetual intercession for His people, and personal visible return to earth. (Matthew 1:18-25; Luke 1:26-38; John 1:1; 20:28; Romans 9:5; 8:46; II Corinthians 5:21; I Peter 2:21-23; John 20:30, 31; Matthew 20:28; Ephesians 1:4; Acts 1:11; Romans 5:6-8; 6:9,10; Hebrews7:25; Hebrews 9:28; I Timothy 3:16)

THE HOLY SPIRIT

We believe in the person of the Holy Spirit who came forth from the Father and Son to convict the world of sin, righteousness, and judgment, and to regenerate, sanctify, and empower all who believe in Jesus Christ. We believe that the Holy Spirit indwells every believer in Christ and that He is an abiding helper, teacher, and guide. (John 14:16,17,26;15:26,27; John 16:9-14; Romans 8:9; I Corinthians 3:16; 6:19; Galatians 5:22-26) MAN

We believe that all men by nature, choice, and practice are sinners but that "God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life." We believe, therefore, that those who repent of their sins and by faith receive Christ as Lord and Savior will rejoice forever in God's presence, and those who refuse to receive Christ as Lord and Savior will be forever separated from God. (John 3:14,16; 5:24; John 5:30; 7:13; 8:12; 10:26; Romans 9:22; II Thessalonians 1:9; Revelation 19:3,20; 20:10;14,15; 21:18; Psalm 51:7; Jeremiah 17:9; James 1:14; Romans 3:19; 5:19; Proverbs 28:13; I John 1:9; John 3:16; John 1:13; II Corinthians 5:17; Romans 8:1)







SALVATION

Salvation involves the redemption of the whole man and is offered freely to all who accept Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior, who by His own blood obtained eternal redemption for the believer. We believe that Jesus tasted death for all men and wants all to be saved. In its broadest sense, salvation includes regeneration, justification, sanctification, and glorification. There is no salvation apart from personal faith in Jesus Christ as Lord. We affirm that the Gospel is the good news that God has made a way of salvation through the life, death, and resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ for any person. This is in keeping with God's desire for every person to be saved. We deny that only a select few are capable of responding to the Gospel while the rest are predestined to an eternity in hell. (Genesis 3:15; Exodus 3:14-17; 6:2-8; Matthew 1:21; 4:17; 16:21-26; 27:22-28:6; Luke 1:68-69; 2:28-32; John 1:11-14, 29; 3:3-21,36; 5:24; 10:9, 28-29; 15:1-16; 17:17; Acts 2:21; 4:12; 15:11; 16:30-31; 17:30-31; 20:32; Romans 1:16-18; 2:4; 3:23-25; 4:3; 5:8-10; 6:1-23; 8:1-18, 29-39; 10:9-10,13; 13:11-14; 1 Corinthians 1:18, 30; 6:19-20; 15:10; 2 Corinthians 5:17-20; Galatians 2:20; 3:13; 5:22-25; 6:15; Ephesians 1:7; 2:8-22; 4:11-16; Philippians 2:12-13; Colossians 1:9-22; 3:1; 1 Thessalonians 5:23-24; 2 Timothy 1:12; Titus 2:11-14; Hebrews 2:1-3; 5:8-9; 9:24-28; 11:1-12:8, 14; James 2:14-26; 1 Peter 1:2-23; 1 John 1:6-2:11; Revelation 3:20; 21:1-22:5.)

ETERNAL STATE

We believe in a literal Heaven, the eternal home of the redeemed. We believe Heaven to be the literal place where the saved will live forever in the eternal bliss and blessings of God. We believe in Hell, the Christ-less eternity for the lost, where there will be burning and tormenting for those without salvation, who have refused to receive the gospel and Jesus Christ as Lord. We believe that Hell, unbelievers, Satan and all the fallen angels shall be cast into the lake of fire to be tormented day and night forever and forever. (Matthew 13:41-43; Mark 9:43-48; Luke 16:19-24; John 14:2; 2 Corinthians 5:8; Revelation 21-22)

BIBLICAL SEPARATION


We believe that all the saved should live in such a manner as not to bring reproach upon their Savior and Lord and that separation from all religious apostasy, all worldly and sinful pleasures, practices and associations is commanded of God. (II Timothy 3:1-5; Romans 12:1-2,14:13; I John 2:15-17; II John 9-11; II Corinthians 6:14-7:1)

BAPTISM

We believe in baptism by immersion after salvation with no merit for salvation in the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. We reject infant baptism and any form of sprinkling for infants or adults. Baptism is an outward expression of our faith in Jesus Christ and simply a public testimony of what God has done by His grace. (Romans 6:1-5; Acts 8:36-38; Acts 2:41; Matthew 3:16; Matthew 28:19-20,24; John 14:2; 2 Corinthians 5:8; Revelation 21-22)

ETERNAL SECURITY

We believe in the eternal security of all blood-bought individuals or believers; that such inheritance is incorruptible and undefiled; and that each believer is kept by the power of God and nothing can separate us from Him, ourselves included. We believe that believers can lose the joy of fellowship with God, can grieve God and can quench the Spirit of God in him or her, but not lose his/her salvation. (John 3:16;5:24; 6:37-39; 10:27-30; Romans 8:35-39; Philippians 1:6; Titus 1:2; 1Peter 1:5; 1 John 5:11-13; Jude 24)







SPIRITUAL GIFTS

We believe that spiritual gifts are given to the church for the express purpose of winning the lost and edifying other believers. The Holy Spirit is given to each believer upon acceptance of Christ and His purpose is to exalt and bring people to Christ. Speaking in tongues was the least important of these gifts and was given as a sign for unbelieving Jews. That is why we do not teach or practice speaking in tongues. (John 7:37-39; 14:17; Acts 2:38; 1 Corinthians 1:22; 3:16-17; 6:19-20; 12-14)

SECOND COMING

We believe in the literal return of Jesus Christ to the clouds to take all saved people from the earth before the beginning of the Tribulation period. We believe in his bodily/visible return with his saints at the close of the Tribulation period to rule and reign for a thousand years on earth. We believe that unbelievers will face God and be judged at the Great White Throne Judgment according to their works, not for salvation, but for their proper and rightful places in the lake of fire. (I Thessalonians 4:13-18, Revelation 4:1, Matthew 16:27; Mark 14:62; John 14:3; Acts 1:11; Phil. 3:20; I Thessalonians 4:15; II Timothy 4:1; Titus 2:13; I Corinthians 4:5; I Corinthians 15; II Thessalonians 1:7-10; Revelation 20:4-6,11-15)

WORLD EVANGELISM

We believe that the apostolic office ceased with the death of the Apostles. We believe that it is His church that He promised continual existence, to continue the work He started until He comes again. We believe that the ministry of reconciliation is committed to every believer and all are saints/priests of God. The Lord Jesus Christ has commanded the preaching of the gospel to all nations. It is the duty and privilege of every follower of Christ and of every church of the Lord Jesus Christ to endeavor to make disciples of all nations. (Matthew16:18; 28:18-20; Mark 16:15; John 20:21; Acts 1:8; 2 Corinthians 5:18-21; 1 Peter 2:9; Revelation 1:6; 5:10)

THE CHURCH

We believe in the local church, consisting of a company of professing, born-again believers in Jesus Christ, immersed on a credible confession of faith, and associated for worship, work and fellowship. We believe that to those local churches we are committed, for a perpetual observance of the ordinances of baptism and the Lord's Supper, and that God has laid upon these churches the task of proclaiming to a lost world the acceptance of Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior and the enthroning of Him as Lord and Master. Its scriptural officers are pastors and deacons. While both men and women are gifted for service in the church, the office of pastor is limited to men as qualified by Scripture. (Matthew 28:18-20; Acts 1:8; Acts 2:42; Romans 6:3-5; I Corinthians11:23-26; Ephesians 2:19-22; Ephesians 5:19-21; 1 Timothy 2:9-14; 3:1-15; 4:14; Hebrews 10:23-25)

The Relationship between Church and State

We believe that every human being is responsible to God alone in all matters of faith and that each church is independent and autonomous and must be free from any ecclesiastical or political authority. Therefore, the Church and the State must be kept separate as having different functions with each fulfilling its duties free from the dictation or patronage of the other. (Matthew 22:21; Mark 12:17; Luke 20:25; Acts 5:29; I Timothy 2:5; Romans 13:1-7; 14:7-9,12)
